Avid Pro Tools Test

This test covers the student's knowledge of Avid Pro Tools. The student may miss up to <u>4 of the non-essential questions</u> to pass. If the student misses one of the **essential questions**, it results in automatic failure for that test. Bolded questions are essential.

1	Locate and open Edit Share. Mount the appropriate drive.
2	Locate and open Pro Tools.
3	Save your project to the TSW Test Edit Share space.
4	Verify the playback engine settings (make sure Scarlet is selected).
5	Create two new tracks and a master track.
6	Set 'Input 1' as the input for track 1 and 'Input 2' as the input for track 2.
7	Record enable the two tracks, turn the volume all the way down on the interface, then turn it back up to -12dB to check your input audio levels on each track.
8	Record several seconds of audio on each track.
9	Move an external audio file to the Edit Share project space.
10	Import the audio file into the project.
11	Select the razorblade tool, cut the audio file, and demonstrate how to use the pointer tool to drag the file within the window.
12	Bring up the mixer window.
13	Raise and lower a fader and explain where their ideal audio levels should be on the master.
14	Review the functions and the buttons on Scarlet.
