

## Canon 7D Competency Test

This test covers the student's knowledge of the Canon 7D Cameras available to Media Production students. Students may miss up to 3 of the non-essential questions and still pass. If a student misses one of the **essential questions**, it results in automatic failure for that test. **Bolded** questions are essential.

1	<b>How do you put on the Battery and turn on the power switch?</b>
2	<b>How do you put a card in the camera?</b>
3	<b>How do you attach and detach the lens?</b>
4	How do you White balance the camera? (AWB/Kelvin)
5	<b>How do you switch to video recording and start recording?</b>
6	How do you manually focus?
7	How do you switch to auto focus?
8	How do you unlock the zoom?
9	How do you zoom?
10	How do you change the aperture?
11	How do you change the shutter speed?
12	How do you change the ISO?
13	How do you switch to Auto ISO
14	Have the student set up the wireless kit on the 7D and connect it to the audio input of the camera.
15	Have the student connect the wireless kit to the H4n.
16	Have the student insert the SD Card into the H4n.

17	<b>Have the student turn on the H4n.</b>
18	How do you determine which source you will be recording with using the H4n, whether external or internal?
19	Have the student put the H4n into 'record standby' and check the audio levels.
20	Ask the student to adjust the audio levels.
21	<b>Ask the student to start recording.</b>
22	What pieces of equipment are included in the Canon 7D camera case along with the camera and where does each one belong?
